



QUICK START MANUAL FOR PROJECT CLEA EXERCISES

The following are simplified step-by-step instructions for downloading and installing a CLEA exercise on a home computer or laptop.

1. Access the CLEA website (<http://www3.gettysburg.edu/~marschal/clea/CLEAhome.html>).
2. On the left-hand panel, select "Software".
3. On the page that appears, select the exercise you want, either by clicking on the name (such as "Spectral Classification of Stars") or on the large icon above it.
4. On the right-hand side of the page that appears, click on the file name (such as "SpecLab.EXE").
5. A small panel will appear that says "Do you want to run or save this file?" Select "Run".
6. The file will download to your computer. How long this will take depends on the size of the software you have selected, and on the speed of your internet connection.
7. When the download completes, you will probably see a small panel that says "The publisher could not be verified. Are you sure you want to run this software?" Select "Run".
8. An InstallShield program will start. Follow the directions. In most cases you can simply accept the defaults as they come up. You will have to select "I accept the terms in the license agreement" when it comes up. From then on you can keep selecting "Next" or "Install" on the panels that appear. Select "Finish" on the final panel.
9. When the install program completes, you should have an icon on your desktop for the exercise program. Double-click on it to run the exercise.
10. Before running the exercise, if you need the Student Manual, return to the page where you downloaded the software (it should still be visible in your browser if you haven't closed or changed it). Click on "Student Manual (Acrobat pdf format)" beneath where you clicked on the program name to download.
11. The Student Manual will appear in Adobe Acrobat. Click on the printer icon on the top to print it.
